# 23rd Annual BLN Day at the Races



Join us for the 23rd annual BLN Day at Emerald Downs. The Boeing Handicap is a stakes race for fillies and mares 3 years and older. It dates back to the first running at Longacres in 1954, and the legacy continues today.

Again this year, a general-admission ticket is \$1, which gives you access to the park, the paddock, and the first five levels of the stadium.

You also get a race-day program and a coupon to buy a hot dog and drink for only \$2. Admission for children 17 and under is free, but you'll need to request the refreshments coupon. No food or drinks may be brought into the facility.


