On Thursday, June 8 members of BLNR and active employees attended the Habitat for Humanity “Beyond the Build” fundraiser luncheon at the Seattle Convention Center. This uplifting event featured a number of interesting speakers. Seattle mayor Bruce Harell spoke about the need for decent, affordable housing in Seattle. Habitat homeowners described how the stability of homeownership allowed their children to go on to college and lead successful lives.



One homeowner described how she and her husband’s college loans prohibited them from buying a home in the open market. They had to live in an RV for some years with four children. An opportunity arose to obtain a Habitat house and now the family is thriving. The keynote speaker described community-led efforts to transform her neighborhood in the South Bronx area. Habitat speakers also described a new goal to build 200 new homes per year – an incredible and inspiring goal!
