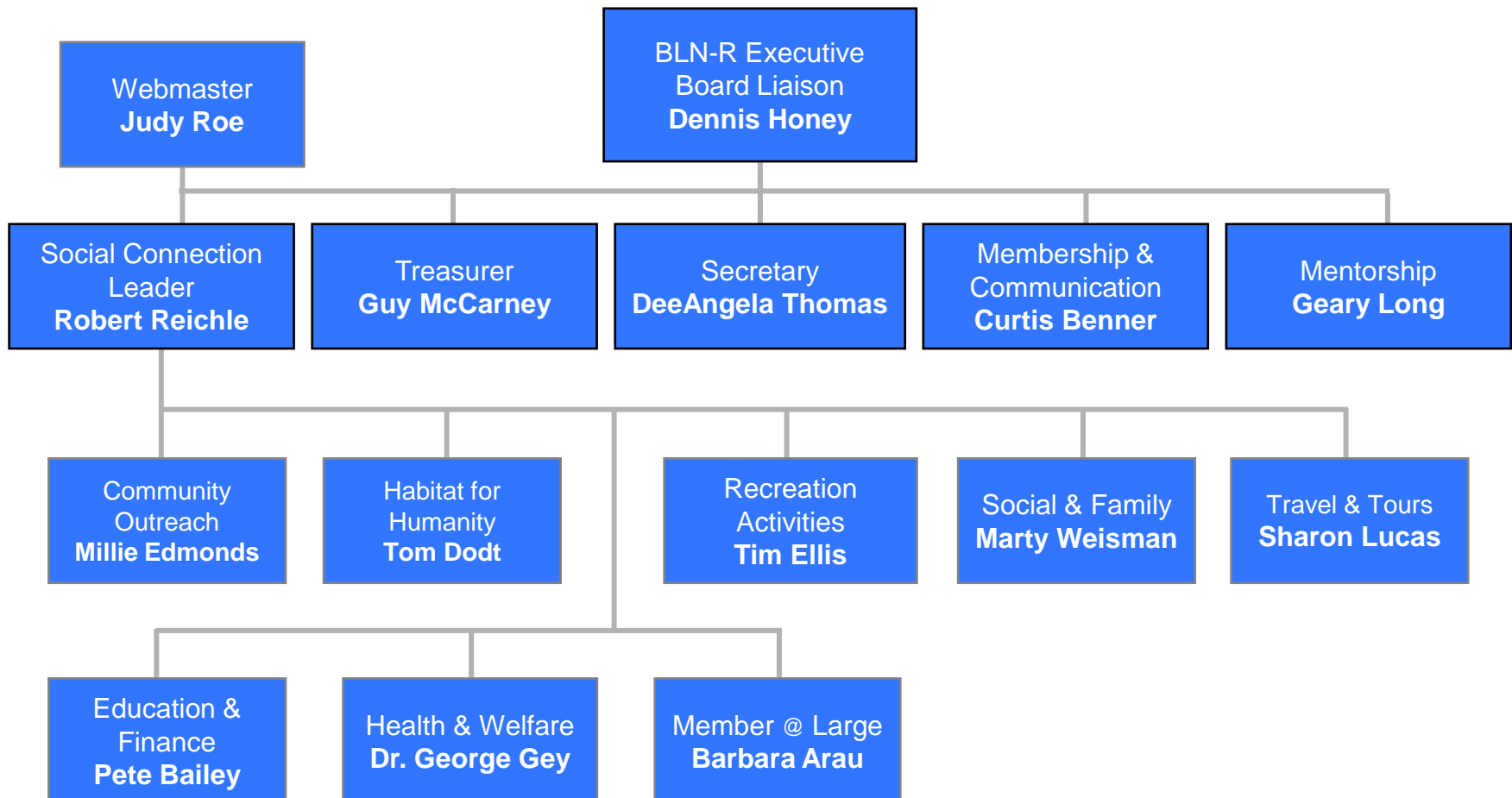

There has been large influx of immigrants from Guatemala & Ukraine, so the number of students who need help this year has increased from 2,030 to 3,649.
