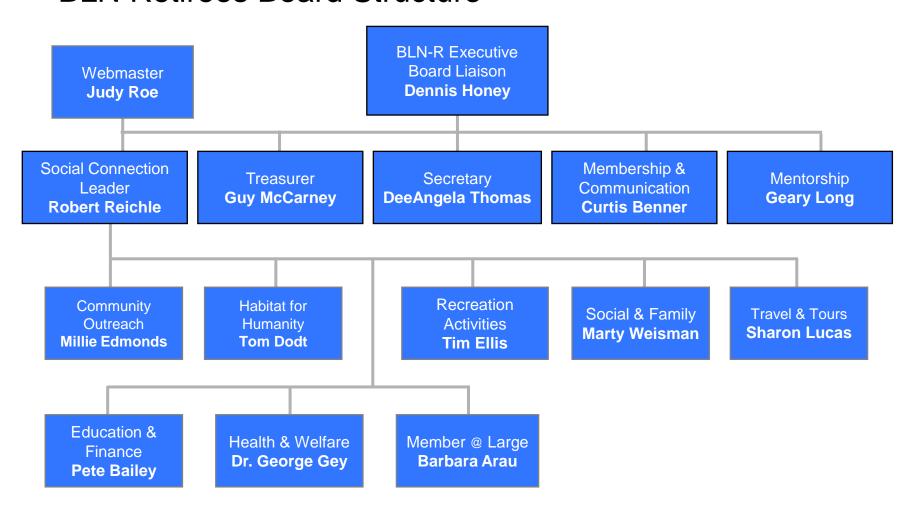

#### Feedback:

- ◆ I have participated twice. I think the ½ hour presentation and ½ hour Q & A works well. I recommend the presenters be given the topic 2 weeks in advance. I also suggest some sessions dedicated to time management, work prioritization, employee development.
- My perspective is a 1 session per month with 2 or 3 BLN retirees works well.
- One suggestion I made to Jenny was a leadership book club. BLN retiree chooses a book and then in 2 or 3 1-hour session the entire group discusses. The BLN retiree is the facilitator and prepares questions to be discussed based on the chapter reading for that week. The format is similar to what I had done at the Ed Wells partnership.



#### Feedback:

I have done one event so far and it went quite well. The attendees were engaged. Growing attendance will be a good area to work on. We had a handful of people at the one I participated in. I know it is early and more will come as we get this going. I will continue to support this as I feel it is a great way to help emerging leaders in the company.

 I signed up with Jenny to support mentoring, however, I've not been called to a session, and have received no indication as to when that might be. I downloaded the software, and am ready to support if and when I get scheduled. So obviously all I can comment on so far is that the program has some ambiguity.



#### Feedback:

- In general, the sessions have been typical to other events that I have participated in throughout my career. Like any event when there are multiple participants in the audience, only a small few actually engage. Conducting the meeting virtually opens the door for the audience to be multi-tasking. This is typical and should be expected. Meaningful discussions will draw the audience in.
- My second group session was much more meaningful. We got into some real-time situations that the first line managers were facing. There was lots of discussion and we actually ran out of time. Hopefully the R-Mentor feedback assisted them with some guidance that they could act upon.
- Going forward, I think we should cut back on R-Mentor introductions to save time. Everyone should have access to our resumes by now. A brief intro by Jenny as to who is participating should be sufficient. Encourage in advance more first line managers to bring forth specific problems that they are dealing with. I think focusing on specific problems, even in a group setting, would be of greater valve to everyone in comparison to general topics.
- Hopefully soon, circumstances will change and open the doors to some lunchtime panel discussions in a face-to-face environment.



#### Feedback:

- It is difficult to work with people when we cannot see them live. Although we have in some cases an image, it is not the same. Sometimes a question is ask, however it is not clear who was asking (image not obvious of who is asking). Sometimes I wonder if I am too far removed from the companies workforce issues to help with mentoring. (retired in 2002) Having to use the phone for audio is just one more inconvenience for those who are tech challenged. I believe a small bio on the participants is useful to associate them with their specific work environment.
- Given the layoff situation ongoing, I wonder how to provide meaningful team morale answers? All I have been able to offer is that try to keep employees engaged by suggesting that their future, including being rehired in the event of being layed off, will depend on how they cope with todays environment? This may not be a very good idea as it may fall on deaf ears? I also suggested that their success is the companies success and pay is augmented by company performance. However this is not useful if their is no company profit.
- I am not sure how you are acquiring participation but there seems to be few that attend? Most likely they are too busy "firefighting" to spend the time? I completely understand. One last comment, it would be better if we could log in at least 10 minutes early to chat. Maybe this constraint is the cost of "running over one hour" but it would be beneficial for us mentors to converse.
- Thx to you and Jenny for the program. These are VERY DIFFICULT" times for all.

## Membership & Communication's Report



- Total Membership (2309) which is an increase of 3 from the October report.
