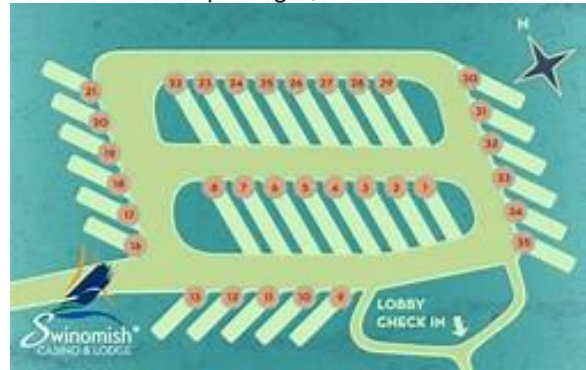


Swinomish Casino (Anacortes) 'Campout' April 20-April 23, 2021
