Dark and stormy French skies dominate this program, with Dukas' *The Sorcerer's Apprentice* opening the concert. Ravel's lush orchestration of Mussorgsky's original work for solo piano vividly brings these images to life. Richard Strauss' Duet Concertino is a

surprising 'first performance' for the Seattle Symphony. Imagined as a dialogue between beauty and the beast, it highlights the lyricism of the clarinet and the gruffer solo bassoon, performed by Benjamin Lulich and Seth Krimsky.
